**SUMMARY:** Responsible for instruction of physical education curriculum while meeting and exceeding appropriate state and national standards for the subject and grade level. Coach assigned sport in accordance with Brentwood's mission and core beliefs.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

#### Classroom Instruction

- Develop and implement informative and engaging lesson plans that fulfill the requirements of the school's curriculum program and reflect differentiation in student learning styles and abilities
- Plan and use appropriate instructional and learning strategies, activities, materials and technology to engage students and increase understanding of the subject matter
- Integrate Biblical Christian perspective into curriculum and instruction while continuously serving as an example and positive role model for students
- Create a classroom environment conducive to learning and appropriate for spiritual, physical and social development of students
- Conduct ongoing assessment of student progress including formative and summative data. Work with parents to improve student progress and address disciplinary issues.
- Work cooperatively with vertical team teachers to determine instructional goals, objectives and methods for student achievement.

#### Coaching

- Oversee all aspects of assigned sport including scheduling and attending all practices and competitions
- Maintain all equipment relative to program and appropriate inventory of apparel
- Coordinate summer sport camps and activities
- Be knowledgeable of and consistently enforce School and TAPPS rules and policies
- Support multi-sport participation for student athletes
- Promote balanced achievement in all areas of school life for student athletes
- Drive students as needed to and from athletic events using school vehicles
- Drive students as needed to and from school events using school vehicles

- Other duties as assigned

- Must have a valid teacher certification or ability to obtain

- Must have 1-3 years of experience teaching in a classroom setting
- Prefer 3+ years coaching at the high school or college level
- Must be an active member of a Church of Christ congregation
- Must be 25 years of age with a valid commercial driver license (or ability to obtain) and an acceptable driving record – *applicable only if coaching a HS level sport*
