Dear Dr. Patterson:

Thank you for your good work in leading the National Christian School Association. I am grateful for the common bond we share in our belief that Christian education goes beyond the simple concept of delivering information to one that fulfills Romans 12, transforming students into people with knowledge of faith who succeed in their studies, careers and lives.

At Lipscomb, we know that paying for a Christian education can be a challenge. With that in mind, I am pleased to announce the Head of School Grant, a scholarship Lipscomb University created specifically for students of NCSA schools.

Beginning in the fall of 2015, graduates from NCSA schools, who qualify for admission into Lipscomb University and submit the required recommendation from their heads of school, will receive a renewable \$5,000 annual scholarship when they enroll as freshmen at Lipscomb and live on campus; those who live off campus will receive a renewable \$2,500 annual scholarship. In addition to the scholarships, students who have a parent employed by an NCSA school will receive a \$1,000 annual tuition discount.

We are enthusiastic about the number of students this grant will benefit and hope that it will make a difference for those seeking to extend their education at a Christian institution. A similar letter was sent to heads of school this week, and we ask for you to share this important information with the NCSA membership as well. Communication from your office will greatly assist us in our efforts to inform graduating students and their parents about the new Head of School Grant.
