I am grateful for the common bond we share in our belief that Christian education goes beyond the simple concept of delivering information to one that fulfills Romans 12, transforming students into people with knowledge of faith who succeed in their studies, careers and lives.

At Lipscomb, we know that paying for a Christian education can be a challenge. With that in mind, I am pleased to offer the Head of School Grant, a grant Lipscomb University created specifically for students of NCSA schools.

Graduates from NCSA schools who qualify for admission into Lipscomb University will receive a renewable \$5,000 annual grant when they enroll as freshmen at Lipscomb in the Fall of 2020 and live on campus; those who live off campus will receive a renewable \$2,500 annual grant. In addition to the NCSA grant, students who have a parent employed by an NCSA school will receive a \$1,000 annual grant after completion of an employee verification form. Furthermore, the Office of Financial Aid at Lipscomb offers traditional merit scholarships alongside NCSA grants, not to exceed full tuition in combination with all other gift aid. It is our hope that these efforts will make a difference for those seeking to extend their education at a Christian institution.
